** ADVISEMENT **

Read instructions completely prior to starting installation. All InDash Mounts are designed so that after installation, phone is facing normal driver position for left-hand drive vehicles. This mount is not designed to be used in foreign countries with right-hand drive vehicles. Use extreme care when working around the plastic components on the dash. Excess force, can cause breakage of the plastic components.

STEP #1: With hook tool pull off the air vent assembly. Begin by inserting the hook tool into the lower corner of the air vent bezel between air vent assembly and radio. Pull to release. Remove air vent assembly carefully as there is a wire connected to the center air vent control wheel. You do not need to remove any wires.

STEP #2: Remove the (2) Phillips screws, vertically positioned that hold the bezel around the radio and include the climate control. Lift off the bezel, as there are only (2) small clips holding it in place. Place soft cloth on the console to protect it. Lift off the bezel and set it on the console.

STEP #3: With Phillips screwdriver, remove the (2) screws that hold the radio in place. Pull out radio enough to get at the screw to the right of the radio. (Optional: remove the lower screw next to the climate control. Place the InDash by PanaVise Mount over the screw hole and replace the screw.

STEP #4: Carefully replace the radio, make sure it is aligned correctly, and replace the (2) screws. Replace the remaining bezels and screws in reverse order.
